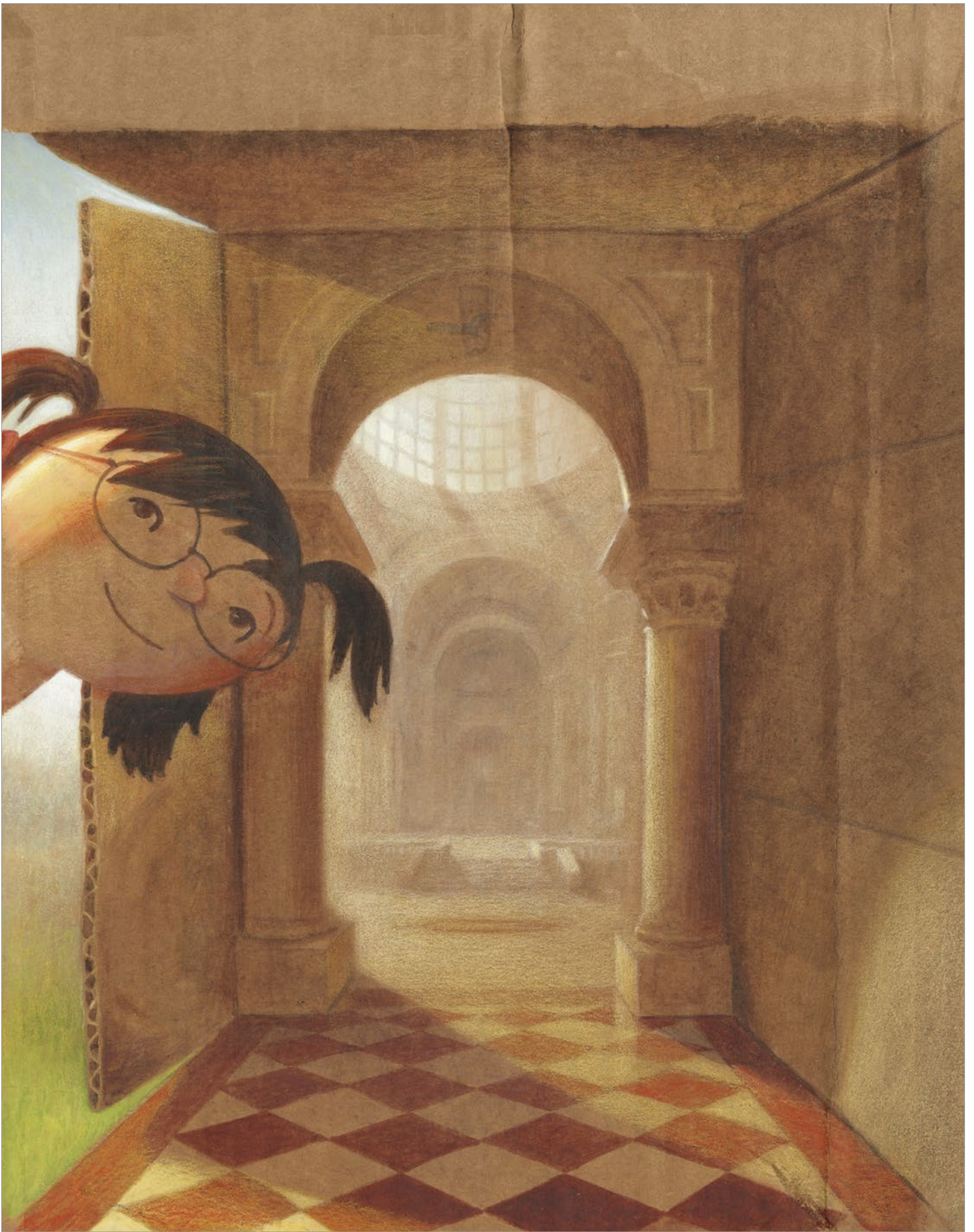

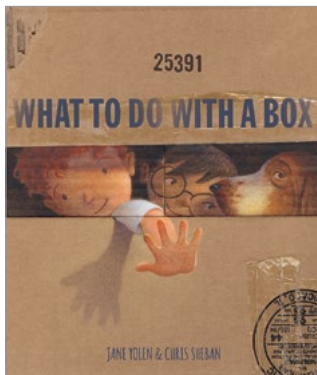


What to Do with a Box

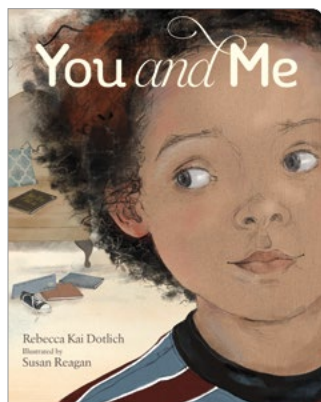


You and Me

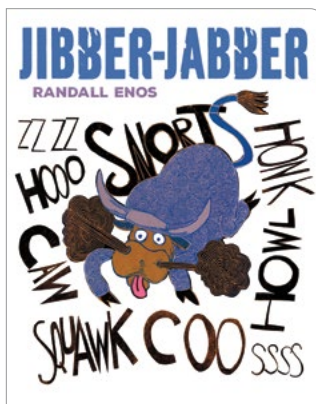

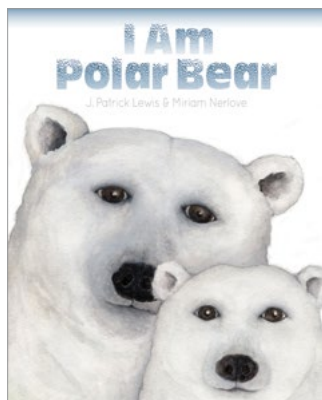


I Am Polar Bear

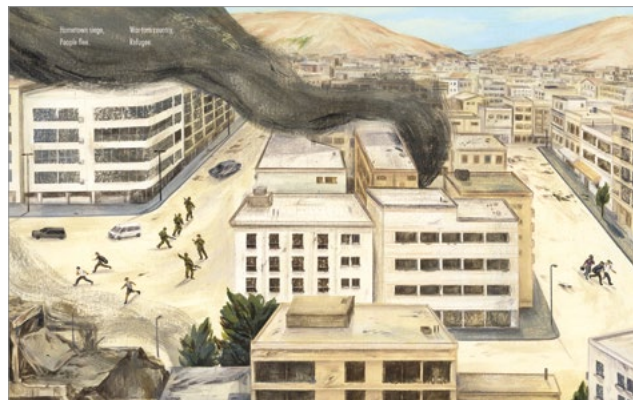
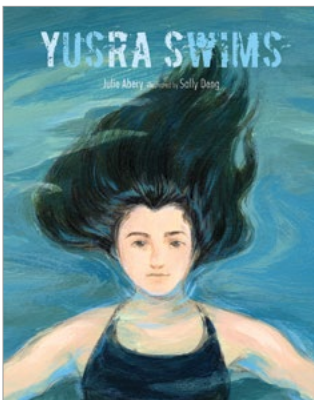


Yusra Swims
