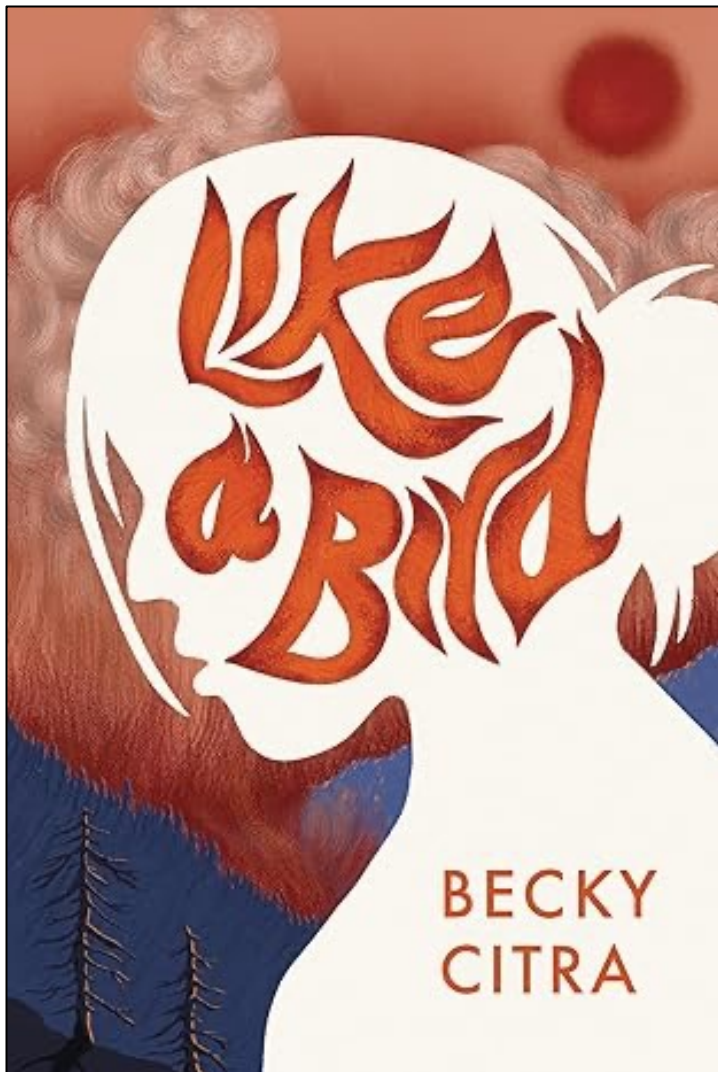
Description:
